- Hurricane Kit Essentials:
 - * First Aid Kit
 - * Battery powered radio with extra batteries
 - * Flashlight with extra batteries
 - * Local maps (you can pick up at any city office)
 - * Water(1 gallon for every person in household)
 - * Keep your gas tank filled during hurricane season
- Make copies of important documents such as proof of homeownership, auto, boats, birth certificates and passports. Take inventory of your personal property on your smart phone or camera.
- Protect your home. Secure all outside items that may fly and cause damage such as patio furniture, loose limbs from trees, and children's play toys.
- Pets! Don't leave home without them! Make sure your pets are included in your hurricane evacuation plan.
